Steve Leung

Recognized internationally, Steve Leung is a leading Architect and Interior Designer born in Hong Kong in 1957. As a dedicated contemporary-style advocate, Steve's works reflect a strong and unique character of minimalism, with skilful adoption of Asian culture and arts. His works include architecture, interior design, as well as product design.

Steve Leung set up his own architectural and urban planning consultancy in 1987 and restructured the company into Steve Leung Architects Limited and Steve Leung Designers Limited in 1997. The company works on a wide spectrum of design projects hotels, restaurants, show flats, club houses, retails etc.

During 1999 - 2012, Steve won the Best Interior Designers Worldwide award in the Andrew Martin International Awards, the Oscars of design, for ten times. The Company has been credited with over 80 design and corporate awards in Asia Pacific region and worldwide, such as IIDA Annual Interior Design Competition, Gold Key Awards, Hospitality Awards and Asia Pacific Interior Design Awards. In recent years, Steve has also been invited to be the juror of several authoritative interior design awards including the Asia Pacific Interior Design Awards 2009, IF Design Award China 2010 and red dot award: product design 2012



本案為Mango Tree在香港銅鑼灣設立的分店。Mango Tree擁有近二十年歷史,以正宗泰國菜聞名全球,梁志天設計師特意以泰國節日為靈感,糅合泰國傳統的藝術元素及當代氣息,將整座餐廳打造成優雅時尚的泰菜食府,讓賓客在香港這國際大都會裡能享受寧靜純樸的泰式情懷。

從電梯步出,復刻自12世紀經典佛像的佛手雕塑在幽幽的燈光下,釋出陣陣禪意,迎接蒞臨的賓客。入口長廊利用鏡子反射兩旁燭光,玻璃屛風上的立體拼紋與茶鏡營塑出神祕深邃的效果,仿似在泰國萬佛節的月圓夜,廟宇燃滿燭光的情景,讓賓客首先感染到寧靜高雅的異國氣息。

通過走廊,動線首先抵達左側的酒吧區,這個時髦的小區域提供賓客在用餐前後與三五知己在此把酒談歡。酒吧區以圓形餐檯配搭弧形沙發、高腳座椅,座區上方一座木製百葉窗吊櫃框塑出視覺亮點,酒吧區背景以銅製雕像、金色蕉葉與曲石飾牆相對,加上木櫃內豐富的仿古碗具和香料裝飾,呈現泰國傳統水上市集風貌中的熱鬧氛圍。

主用餐區鋪設泰國柚木地板,一盞盞或高或低的前衛吊燈在深色玻璃天花板的反射下顯得 璀璨奪目,佈置靈感取自泰國傳統天燈節漫天燈火的景致,冷冽質材的運用為這個場景加入 了時髦的現代感。沙發後方的泰絲飾牆上綴有荷葉形的青銅藝術裝置,配合可移動的黑橡木 雕花屏風以及優雅的咖啡色家具、泰式仿古藝術品,處處流露出東方情調。主用餐區與兩間 包廂則使用滑軌門片分隔,可依照不同的活動需求靈活組合空間,房間內的柚木天花板與金 色絲質壁紙,亦為這裡鋪陳了溫暖又貴氣的空間氛圍。



Mango Tree has been an authentic Thai food restaurant for more than twenty years. Its' recently open branch in Causeway Bay Hong Kong was designed by Steve Leung. Steve was inspired by Thai religious festival and used traditional Thailand craft art to furnish the space for a genuine Thai culture experience.

In the elevator hall, light casts on a Buddha's hand piece from the twentieth century; the gesture seems to welcome the customers in a warm embracement. In front of the hall, there is a pathway clad with mirrors with millions of candle light dots; it guides everybody to submerge into an experience like a Thai Buddhist Temple.

At the end of this hallway, there is a bar, a place to entertain customers before having a formal dinner. The space is embellished with a curved shape sofa, high bar chairs, wooden blinds and copper sculptures; in a wood chest, there are lines of cups, bowls and dining utensils. The place provides a visual link to Bangkok's famous water market.

The main dining hall is paved in Thai pattern teak wood. At the top there are several irregularly shaped lamps lined up at different heights. The whole scene reminds one of a spatial impression like the sky view in Thailand's famous sky lantern day. Other embellishments include fine craft silk pattern on sofas, copper sculptures, and a black color hollowed screen. All of the furnishing work provides a strong impression of Thailand culture. A sliding door separates the main dining hall and private rooms can be provided to reduce the size for any

Colors in the box rooms are an earthy base while the gold color thread pattern gives the room a sense of luxury.

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
